Closest Airport and Train Station Transport	Airport : Warsaw "Chopin" International Airport Railway station : Warsaw Central The organizer will provide transfers between the Warsaw airport or railway station and official hotel and between the official hotel and competition venue. Transportation will be offered only to those participants who are accommodated in the official hotel. Participating National Federations are responsible for their own travel to the Poland, Warsaw.		
Participation	This <i>European Open</i> is open for all EJU / IJF Member Federations: <u>Maximum 4 competitors per weight category for every federation.</u> The competitors must be of the same nationality as the national federation, which enters them.		

Accreditation. Control of entries	<p>At least one team official and maximum two must attend the accreditation on Friday 01th of March from 10:00 to 18:00 in order to confirm the delegation. Without this confirmation in time a nation will not be put into draw and not be allowed to start. Each Head of Delegation must be present, during the control of participants, with proof of their nationality (passport or national ID card with photography or photocopy of a document).</p>
Age	Minimum 15 years of age (born in 1998 or before)
Competition Mode	<p>The competition will be carried out according to the rules and sporting codes of the IJF and EJU. The new testing rules approved for a period until the WC Rio de Janeiro 2013 will be applied for the European Open.</p> <p>Competition system: An elimination (KO) system with the quarterfinal (last 8) repechage.</p>
Duration of contests	5 minutes - Golden Score without time limit.
Weigh-in	<p>Athletes must present their <i>EJU accreditation</i> and Passport or national ID card with photography at the official weigh-in.</p> <p>For time and place of the official weigh-in see the Program.</p> <p>The scales for check of the weight will be provided from 8:00 until 19:00 in Hotel Radisson Sobieski on days of the official weight-in.</p>
Refereeing	<p>Each federation may enter 1 referee with at least continental licence and valid classification A or B.</p> <p>The organizing federation may enter a maximum of 4 referees.</p> <p>A referee meeting will be held on Friday 01th of March at 19:00 hrs at the Hotel Radisson Sobieski.</p> <p>The attendance to the Referee meeting is strictly compulsory. The referees should be dressed formally for this meeting.</p>
Draw	<p>Seeding of the Top 8 among the entered competitors according to the IJF World Ranking List. The rest s of the draw – separation by nations.</p> <p>The draw will take place on Friday 01th of March at 20:00hrs in Hotel Radisson Sobieski. Each delegation must be represented at the draw, maximum two officials.</p> <p><u>Dress code:</u> jacket suit with tie.</p>
Jumas	<p>All entries must be registered in JUMAS (EJU online registration system). http://www.jumas12.net/user/login</p> <p>Deadline for registration is Monday, 25th of February 2013</p> <p>Delegates not registered in Jumas will be charged 30 € late entry fee. Jumas membership ordered on site will cost € 30 per membership.</p>
Entry Fee	An entry fee of 10 € per athlete must be paid to the EJU during accreditation.
Coaching	<p>All coaches must fully adhere to the Code of Conduct for Judo Coaches.</p> <p>Dress Code: ▶Draw: jacket suit and tie ▶Elimination rounds: national track suit with trousers reaching down to shoes or jacket suit with tie. ▶For the final block program (TV time): jacket suit with tie.</p>
Judogi	<p>The white and blue judogi are obligatory. Judogi control according to Sokuteiki Rule. All Judoka must compete in IJF Approved Judogi. See Official Suppliers on the EJU website. Judogi markings must be in accordance with the EJU regulations. Detailed information is available on http://www.eju.net/statutes</p> <p>If the Judogi of the athlete does not comply with all the specifications of the EJU and the IJF, including the Back Number, the athlete will be disqualified from the tournament.</p>

<p>Back Numbers</p>	<p>Each competitor taking part in the EJU events is obliged to have on the back of his Judogi the official 2011 EJU / IJF back number.</p> <p>The back number must be the official EJU / IJF one. <p>Responsibility of the Federations</p>	<p><i>The competitors will compete under the full responsibility of their federations.</i></p> <p>Insurance: <i>Each national federation is responsible for insuring its competitors against 'injury and third part risk (public liability)' during the period of the championships. The European Judo Union and Polish Judo Association decline all responsibility.</i></p>
<p>Anti Doping</p>	<p>The Gold Medal Winner and another drawn medallist from each weight category have to undergo the doping control. Detailed guidelines and information can be found on the EJU website : http://www.eju.net/statutes</p>
