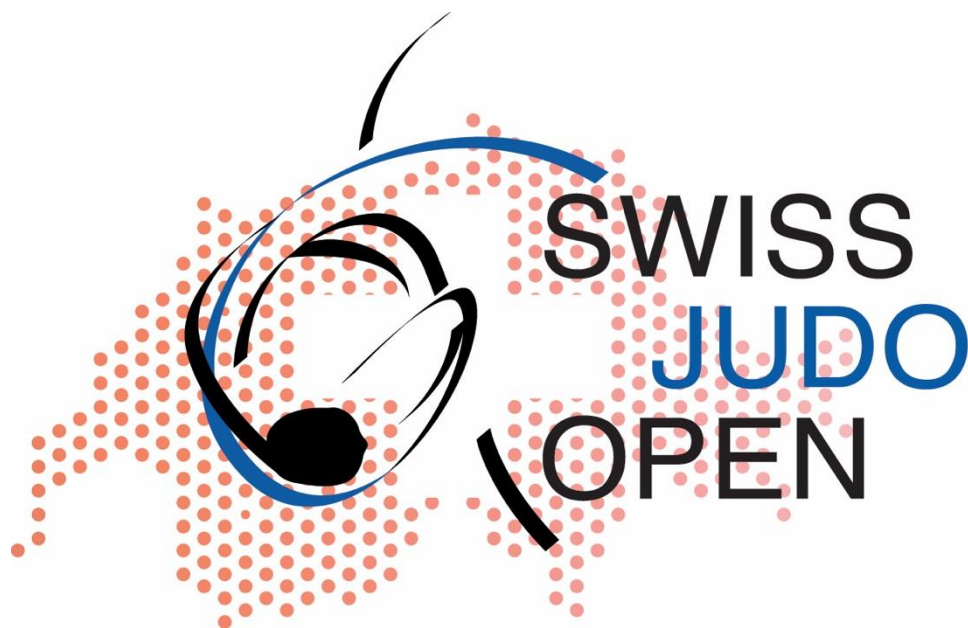

4. Age

15 years and over (Born in 2005 and before)

5. Participation

This Senior European Judo Cup is open for all EJU/IJF Member Federations. There is no limit in the number of participation for each weight category for every federation. The competitors must be of the same nationality as the National Federation, which enters them.

6. Categories & Duration

Male: -60kg, -66kg, -73kg, -81kg, -90kg, -100kg, +100

Female: -48kg, -52kg, -57kg, -63kg, -70kg, -78kg, +78kg

Duration: 4 minutes Golden Score: No time limit

7. Entry Fee

An EJU entry fee of **10€** per athlete must be paid in order to participate to the contest.

8. JUDOBASE Registration

All participants and delegates must be registered for this event in the IJF Registration System (**JUDOBASE**): <https://admin.judobase.org/> .

Deadline for JUDOBASE Registration is **Monday March 02nd 2020**.

After the deadline further registrations (late entries, replacements) are exclusively handled during accreditation according to the following rules:

Please note:

- Above mentioned late entry fee has to be paid in cash on spot.
- Persons without IJF ID Card can only be entered on spot, if IJF ID Card will be ordered until end of Accreditation.
- Persons, who are banned by their Federation cannot be entered as late entry or replacement.

10. Accreditation & Control of Nationality

At least one team official and maximum two must attend the accreditation on **Friday from 10:00 to 17:00** in order to confirm the delegation. One delegation may also be represented by

an official of another delegation or by a national federation representative, on written notification of the delegation. Without this confirmation in time, a nation/club will not be put into the draw and will not be allowed to compete. Passports or photocopies of passports from all competitors must be available on request (national ID Card showing nationality, picture and date of birth or a copy is also accepted). An EJU accreditation card with a photograph will be issued to competitors and officials.

11. Competition Mode

The competition will be conducted in accordance with the latest IJF SOR and IJF Refereeing Rules.

Competition systems according to number of participants:

- 6 and more entries: Double repechage
- 3,4,5 entries: Round robin
- 2 entries: better of 2 fights, if 1-1 the third match will decide

In order for an athlete to obtain points for the European Ranking List, her/his weight category should have participants from at least 2 different countries. If this is not the case, the competition can still be held, according to the organiser's decision.

If, by the nominal deadline, there is only one country inscribed in any weight category, the organiser is obliged to inform immediately the National Federation concerned.

12. Draw

The draw will take place on **Friday at 20:00hrs.**

The top four (4) from the entered competitors in each weight category will be seeded according to the current EJU European Ranking List.

13. Weigh-in

Official weigh-in for each weight category is held the evening before the competition day (see program). Athletes must present their EJU accreditation card and his/her passport (National ID Cards showing nationality, picture and date of birth are also accepted).

- Random weight checks of 4 (four) athletes per weight category (except for the + categories) with the same rules as the official weigh-in can be organized before the first fights in the morning of the competition. The weight of the athlete cannot be more than 5% higher (without judogi) than the official maximum weight limit of the category. **Athletes must present their EJU accreditation card, passport is not required. The Official weigh-in and Random weigh-in will proceed according to related Articles of IJF SOR.**

14. Refereeing

Each federation may enter 3 referees. The organizing federation may enter as many referees as required for the realization of the tournament, but giving priority to their own Continental/International referees first and then their national referees with the highest national license with at least 2 years of experience. However, if enough Continental/International referees are inscribed in Judobase, the organizing federation has to limit its number of national referees to 1 per mat.

The Referee Meeting will be held on Friday evening (see program). The attendance to the Referee meeting is strictly compulsory. The referees should be dressed formally for this meeting.

JUDOBASE registration deadline for referees: Friday, February 21st 2020

The bow:

- The contestants must not shake hands BEFORE the start of the contest.
- When the athletes are leaving the mat they must wear judogi in proper way and are not allowed to take out any part of the judogi or the belt before leaving the field of play.

15. Coaching

All coaches must fully adhere to the Code of Conduct for Judo Coaches.

16. Transport

Airport: **Zürich International Airport (ZRH)**

The organizer will provide transfers between the Airport and official hotels, between the official hotels and the venue. Transportation will be offered only to those participants who are accommodated via the organiser. The transfers are only offered on the days when the delegations are booked in an official hotel through the organisers.

17. Entry fee

The local entry fee of 50€ per athlete will be charged.

There is no obligation to stay at the official hotel.

Cancellations:

Important: Injuries, visa problems or sickness are not valid reasons for cancellation of rooms.

Reservations at the official hotels have to be booked exclusively through the organiser on a first come – first serve base.

Possible reservations of extra rooms after the hotel reservation deadline will be surcharged with an additional 10% - upon availability. NO exceptions will be made.

Countries which cannot make bank transfers are entitled to pay in cash money upon arrival without any surcharge, if they inform the organiser and specify the number of participants before the hotel reservation deadline.

In case of any damage to hotel property or competition venue caused by members of a delegation, their national federation will be charged by the organising committee.

All bank fees and money transfer costs must be paid by the sender federation.

The person attending accreditation must bring proof of the bank transfer.

20. Judogi Control

Approved Judogi

All Judoka must compete in IJF Approved Judogi (only red label allowed) and Judogis from all IJF suppliers are allowed (see www.ijf.org Official Supplier List).

Judogi Control

It will be operated with a Sokuteiki prior to the fight. Judogi must have an IJF Official Label "APPROVED JUDO GI" with an optical code which cannot be falsified. The label will be controlled with an optical lamp. Each of the competition clothing articles (jacket, trousers and belt) must have an IJF official label.

Backnumber

Each competitor taking part in the EJU events is obliged to have sewn on the back of his Judogi the official backnumber (both EJU and IJF are allowed) bearing his surname and his National

Olympic Committee abbreviation. The backnumber can be ordered from www.mybacknumber.com or www.officialbacknumber.com (Attention: production and delivery may take around 4 weeks). The SPONSOR part (if needed) will be given to the head of delegation during registration, and the athletes can stick it themselves using the special glue on the back number.

Markings and Advertising

The space on the **shoulder stripes** (25cm x 5 cm on both right and left side) and on the upper arms (10cm x 10cm on both right and left side) can be either used for own sponsors of the Federation or Judoka or EJU Suppliers, **BUT not for any other Judogi supplier**. The space on the **right chest** (5cm x 10cm) can be used by the Judoka for his/her own sponsor. The logo of a Judogi brand can only be used, if it corresponds with the brand of the Judogi itself and if it is an EJU Supplier. Further, no logo of a competing brand of the advertising reserved for the Federation can be used (unless approval granted by the Federation).

The space on the **left chest** (10cm x 10cm) can be used for the national colours or the national emblem corresponding with the IOC code on the backnumber (regional emblems are not allowed).

All other markings on the Judogi, like Judogi brand logos, name of Judoka, etc. have to comply with the IJF Judogi Rules.

Important:

- If an athlete does not respect the Judogi rules, the athlete will not be permitted to pass the Judogi Control, and the coach who is responsible for the athlete will be suspended for the rest of the competition day.
- The organiser is not obliged to provide reserve Judogi at Judogi Control, but the athlete is allowed to present himself in another IJF Approved Judogi, complying with the Sokuteiki rule (and without backnumber) - in this case no coach can go with this athlete to the mat!
- In the case of a repeated offence the coach will be suspended for the rest of the competition.

21. Responsibility of Federations

The competitors will compete under the full responsibility of their federations. Insurance: Each national federation is responsible for insuring its competitors against "injury and third part risk (public liability)" during the period of the event. The European Judo Union and the Swiss Judo Federation decline all responsibility.

Consent for Photography/Videos/Filming

Delegates inscribed by their National Federations for EJU events consent to the EJU and its media partners to use content of them, including data, live results, photographs and/or video recordings (hereafter referred to as Media). This media may be obtained from National Federations and EJU. It will also be acquired by the EJU and its media partners from in and around all EJU event venues. Media could be used in print and digital media formats including print publications, websites, e-marketing, posters banners, advertising, film, broadcast, social media, education purposes and other purposes. The National Federation must ensure that they have the permission of each delegate or in the case of a minor the permission of the parent/guardian. If a delegate does not give consent, then the National Federation must inform the European Judo Union by writing to headoffice@eju.net.

22. Anti-Doping

Anti-doping tests might be executed according to the IJF MEDICAL AND ANTI-DOPING HANDBOOK (IJF SOR – Appendix E).
